

**** Summer School classes at Mountain Bay ******Developmental Courses**

Basic Skills - Grades K-5 (at DCE Middle School)

This program will offer activities to build academic readiness skills through play, themed literature, and a variety of hands-on experiences. Pre-reading, pre-writing, pre-math, social skills, gross and fine motor skills, and daily living skills will be addressed.

Developmental Math - Grade 2

This session is designed to provide instruction in basic mathematics skills for students needing additional instruction and practice. The daily instruction will focus on the skills of computation and problem solving through the use of math games, computers, and direct instruction.

Stupendous Scholars (Developmental Reading) - Grade 2

Reading and writing galore! Students will extend literacy learning throughout the summer by participating in this developmental reading course.

Enrichment Courses

Math Madness!! (Enrichment Math) - Grade 2

Students will explore measurement and organizing data with hands-on activities. Geometry, place value, and multiplication will also be investigated through a variety of literature, art creations and games!

Nature, Bugs, and Fun!!! - Grades 2-3

Have you ever wanted to meet a mantis or chat with a cockroach? This class explores the fascinating lives of insects. We care for a "Bug Zoo" in our classroom which includes insects, amphibians, reptiles and a worm farm. We explore in "the wild" with weekly nature walks. If you enjoy nature and animals, you will meet lots of new ones that probably live in your own backyard.

On Stage - Performing With Books (Enrichment Reading) - Grades 2-3

Through a variety of literary selections, participants will explore theatrical experiences through the use of reader's theater, plays, poetry, and tableau. Literature will be a major component as students discuss, analyze and compare various literary works in addition to performing.

Project Funway -- Either you are in or you are out! - Grades 2-3

Embark on a fun filled journey to learn more about one of our favorite childhood authors Patricia Polacco. Use technology to create commercials, presentations and artwork as we deepen our knowledge about this award winning author and illustrator and how she overcame learning obstacles and eventually became an award winning writer.

Science in ACTION! - Grades 2-3

Unlock (some of) the mysteries of the world! Gain a better understanding of how motion, forces, simple machines, and chemical reactions work, by taking part in fun and engaging hands-on science experiments. Most experiments use readily available household materials, so many of the experiments that we do in class can be easily recreated at home (with parental approval).

Sports for Life - Grades 2-3

Summer Sun Reading Celebration (Enrichment Reading) - Grade 2
